



Antique and Historical Displays

SAFETY RULES, REGULATIONS, AND INFORMATION

1. No exhibits are to be moved without permission or escort of an IPM 2022 Committee member.
 2. Working displays will be provided with “show time” notice boards.
 3. Exhibit description signage will be provided.
 4. Security will be provided in the tented city from 6 pm on Friday, Sept. 16 to 6 pm on Sunday Sept. 25.
 5. Neither Ontario Plowmen’s Association, nor the Local Committee of the 2022 International Plowing Match and Rural Expo can be held responsible for theft, damage or accidents.
 6. The 2022 IPM reserves the right to take action against any exhibitor not following rules.
 7. All operators of motor vehicles must have a valid driver’s license (or for tractors only be at least 18 years of age).
 8. Working equipment must be attended to at all times. Displays/shows areas must have a defined, tidy perimeter, with barriers where necessary.
 9. Report all unsafe practices or conditions to an IPM 2022 committee member. When necessary, further safety regulations may be issued during IPM.
 10. No merchandising of any kind is allowed on the grounds of the Antiques and Historical Display without the express written consent of the Ontario Plowmen’s Association.
 11. All applications are subject to a selection routine. Approval notice will be issued by Ontario Plowmen’s Association and/or the 2022 International Plowing Match and Expo Local Committee.
 12. Preference will be given to unique antiques with a strong connection to the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville.
 13. Please note: The deadline for registration will be **Sept. 1, 2022**.
 14. Exhibits must arrive **by 4 pm on Sept. 19** and remain on-site for the duration of the Match.
 - a. Exhibitors are responsible for making arrangements for transporting their exhibits.
 - b. To complete registration, all exhibitors must provide a valid insurance certificate that states they carry a minimum of \$2 million comprehensive liability insurance and lists the Ontario Plowmen's Association and the 2022 International Plowing Match & Rural Expo as additional insured.
 - c. Steam boilers must be licensed and certified.
 - d. No exhibitor vehicles are allowed on the show grounds during public hours: 8:30 am - 5 pm.
 - e. Overnight camping is not permitted on the show grounds
 - f. Only service animals are allowed on the IPM grounds.
 - g. All exhibitors with working displays must have their fire extinguisher and first aid kit.

15. Exhibitors will be provided with passes on the following basis:
 - a. Static display/display collections (non-working): 1 pass only in total per exhibitor (total 1 pass)
 - b. Working exhibits: Passes issued based on requirements to ensure optimal operation of the exhibit throughout the Match. Passes issued after discussions with and approval by the local IPM Antiques and Historical Committee.
