Showcase Niagara community spirit with this year's Beautification Competition

GRASSIE, Ontario (May 12, 2025) – The return of the iconic International Plowing Match & Rural Expo (IPM) to Niagara for the first time in almost 100 years offers a unique chance for the Niagara communities to shine.

The five-day IPM will take place this September and preparations are well underway to welcome the thousands of anticipated visitors.

One of the most anticipated lead-up activities is the Beautification Competition, inviting residents and organizations to highlight the natural charm and community spirit that defines Niagara.

The Beautification Competition is open to individuals, families, businesses and community organizations offering a total of \$4,200 in cash prizes. Entries will be judged in seven different categories: Residential, Farm/Rural, Big Bale, Townships, Business/Commercial, School/Church/Senior Residence, Niagara & Haldimand 4-H. Each category will present three awards: \$300 for first place, \$200 for second, and \$100 for third.

Participants will be evaluated out of 100 points with the judging criteria focusing on the best use of flowers, incorporation of the official IPM colours (blue and green), creative interpretation of the 2025 theme, "From Our Farm to Your Table," and the overall visual impact and appeal of the display.

"This is a special opportunity for our region to truly shine," says Anne Marie Chechalk, chair of the Beautification Competition. "From vibrant gardens to creative storefront displays this competition gives us a chance to showcase the unique beauty and community pride found throughout Niagara. We can't wait to see the colourful results," she says.

Whether you're planting a stunning front yard display or dressing up your business for the occasion these community efforts will help showcase the best of our region.

Submissions must include an 8" x 10" high-resolution JPG photo of the display and be sent by email to beautification@ipm2025.ca. A \$10 entry fee is required and can be submitted by e-transfer to ipm2025sales@outlook.com.

The competition is open to everyone and all entries must be received by August 25, 2025.
